### General Information

Membership is open to clubs, societies, and other organisations anywhere in the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, or Northern Ireland, who are engaged in model engineering or related subjects. Whilst at the moment the majority of our member organisations are railway and steam orientated, all types of model engineering, horology, and miniature engineering are embraced.

The Northern Association is operated on democratic principles, and as such, all important issues and matters of policy are determined by meetings of Delegates of member societies, of which there are normally two per year, one in the spring which is normally preceded by the A.G.M. and the other in the autumn, to which each of our affiliated organisations is entitled to send a delegate who may vote, and an observer..

The day to day running of the Association is undertaken by the officers who are elected by the delegates, normally for a period of three years and work within the policies determined at the delegates meetings.

An insurance service is provided through Walker Midgley Insurance Brokers who administer a comprehensive scheme on our behalf, (please note that this is not a pre-requisite for membership) which not only covers the requirements of clubs and societies, but also individual members, their models, workshops, home and contents, motor, etc, etc, all at discounted rates.
